

## UWEP 2024 Annual Information

UWEP provides services to both DDA Participants, and DVR Customers. DDA Participants are provided long term support at their jobs, billed by the hour for a flat per hour rate. DVR Customers are provided short term contracts including Community Based Assessments, Job Placement, Retention Plans, Intensive Training Plans, and Independent Living Services, which are invoiced at the completion of the contract. DVR Customers may or may not also be receiving DDA services.
